CANAZEI, VAL DI FASSA, TRENTO

La Val di Fassa si sviluppa per una ventina di chilometri nel cuore delle Dolomiti ed è un autentico concentrato di meraviglie naturali. Un tripudio di vette che da Moena a Canazei lasciano letteralmente senza fiato. Roda di Vael, Catinaccio, Sassolungo, Sella, Marmolada e Monzoni sono solo alcune delle cime più famose della Val di Fassa. Una terra ricca di fascino, culla di molti sport estivi e invernali, che conquista con l'ottima gastronomia, la millenaria cultura ladina e le tante leggende, come quella di Re Laurino che, si racconta, abbia fatto di questo paradieso di rocce e foreste il suo regno incantato.

Val di Fassa develops in the heart of the Dolomites along 20 kilometres and it is an authentic heap of natural wonders. A triumph of pinnacles that from Moena to Canazei leaves literally breathless. Roda di Vael, Catinaccio, Sassolungo, Sella, Marmolada and Monzoni are only some of the most famous peaks of Val di Fassa. An area rich in charm that is cradle of many summer and winter sports, that conquers through its excellent gastronomy, its thousand-year old Ladin culture and its legends, such as the one about King Laurin, who is told to have established his enchanted kingdom in this paradise of rocks and forests.

The Short Program for Boys' Singles shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen.
- b) Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps, may not repeat jump a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump a) or b)
- d) Camel, sit or upright spin (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot) with change of foot and no flying entrance.
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). Flying entry is allowed.
- f) One step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

The Short Program for Girls' Singles shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
- b) Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps, may not repeat jump a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump a) or b)
- d) Layback/sideways leaning spin or spin in one basic position with no change of foot (minimum six (6) revolutions).
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). Flying entry is allowed.
- f) One step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Jumps not according to Short Program requirements (wrong number of revolutions) will receive no value.

If the same jump is executed as a solo jump and as a part of the jump combination, the repeated jump will not be counted (if this repetition is in a jump combination, only the individual jump which is not according to the above requirements will not be counted).

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- a) Maximum 6 jump elements for Girls and 7 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.
Only two (2) jumps with three (3) or more revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or a jump sequence. Any single, double (including Double Axel) or triple jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with change of foot (minimum eight (8) revolutions), flying entrance is not allowed and one must be a flying spin (minimum six (6) revolutions) or a spin in one position with change of foot and a flying entrance (minimum eight (8) revolutions). There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Levels explanations:

For Advanced Novice Singles, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 3 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Transitions
- Performance
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is

- a) Short Program
 - for boys 0.9
 - for girls 0.8
- b) Free Skating
 - for boys 1.8
 - for girls 1.6

Girls and Boys Free Skating 3.00 min. +/- 10 sec.

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles B boys and girls must contain:

- a) Maximum of 5 jump elements for Girls and 6 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequence. A jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 e ½) or more revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Any single, double jump (including Double Axel) or triple jumps cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position. The spin combination with a change of foot and a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. The spin in one position with change of foot minimum of eight (8) revolutions or spin in one position without change of foot minimum six (6) revolutions. In both spins flying entries are allowed.
- c) There must be one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is

- for boys	2.0
- for girls	1.7

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles A must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girl and Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump.

There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequence. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single and double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position. The spin combination with change of foot and a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. The spin in one position with change of foot minimum of eight (8) revolutions or spin in one position without change of foot minimum six (6) revolutions. In both spins flying entries are allowed.

c) There must be one (1) step sequence with fully utilizing the ice surface.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factor of the Program Components is 2.5.

For Basic Novice A Singles, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

A well balanced CUBS Free Skating program must contain:

Free Skating. Duration: 2.00 min. +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump.
There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequence. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total).and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
 - for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position.The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
 - for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

For Cubs in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

A well balanced CHICKS Free Skating program must contain:

Free Skating. Duration: 2.00 min, +/- 10 sec.

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump.
There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
 - for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
 - for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation:

For Chicks in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The program Components are only judged in:

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factor of the Program Components is 2.5

SENIOR WOMEN AND MEN International regulations

Only free program

Free Skating. Duration: 4.00 min, +/- 10 sec Women

4.30 min, +/- 10 sec Men

Panel Judges

Each nation may nominate one international judge for the competition. The judge will be guest of the Organizing Committee. The Panel of judges shall consist of 7 judges for the "senior" and "junior" levels and 5 judges for all other levels. The draw for the Judges Panels takes place on the occasion of the first Judges Meeting.

Calculation of results:

- OBO System: Interpretative - Groups.
- New System: Chicks - Cubs - Springs - Debs - Novices - Junior - Senior.

Interpretative

Levels:

a) Born in 2005/2006/2007/2008 - Free program: 2 min. (10" bonus)

In the program are allowed only 2 single jumps, not repeated and not in combination;

b) Born in 2002/2003/2004 - Free program: 2 min. (10" bonus)

In the program are allowed only 3 single jumps, not repeated and not in combination;

c) Born in 2001 and before - Free program: 2 min. 30 sec. (10" bonus)

In the program are allowed all single jumps, not repeated and not in combination.

Attention: a program with other jumps means disqualification of the athlete.

Music: accept the vocal.

Costums: according to the interpretation of the music-theme.

Objects: allowed if transported only by the athlete and if strictly necessary for the Performance and not dangerous for the ice. The maximum time for transported the objects in the ice it's 30" seconds.

Penalty extratime: 1 point for judge

Judges panels and scores - three judges as following:

- judge only artistic value: jumps, spins, skating;

- judge global value: global program;

- judge only choreography-dance value: interpretation, posture, originality of program.

The score is only one each judge and the mark is minimum 0.0 and maximum 6.0.

Final result: majority position; in case of equal position, the best result in the interpretative value wins.

Groups

Each group must consist of at least 8 athletes for each team.

Each athlete may participate to and compete for only one group.

GROUPS LEVELS AND PERFORMANCES TIMES

There is no age limit and skaters of both sexes are allowed.

The Performance time for each group is between 2'30" and 4'.

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

It is allowed to take onto the ice rink or close to it objects made of paper, cardboard, fabric, rope, wood, metal, etc. which are strictly necessary to the performance. They have to be brought inside by the skaters themselves and the dimensions may not exceed 20 sq. meters. Such objects shall be checked by the members of the Complaint Commission before the beginning of the performance. It is absolutely prohibited to make use of chemical smoke-producers or of any other dangerous material. There will be a penalty for the team which should not respect the above mentioned regulation. The Judges Panel shall not, when voting for artistic merit, consider such objects, as they are part of the choreographic setup for which no merit is provided. If a group should have to stop the performance due to forte majeure, it will be allowed to repeat the whole performance, whichever span of time shall have elapsed at the time of suspension. The teams have to provide two copies of the performance soundtrack.

JUDGES PANEL

For this sporting event a panel of 5 judges will be appointed and they will have to vote comprehensively and not analytically. Judgments shall have to be based on the evaluation of the group as a whole, disregarding any individual difficulty. The standing shall be drawn by the ranking system.

SCORES

Each judge shall have two boards for voting: the first one with digits from 0 to 6 for integers and the second one with digits from 0 to 9 for decimals. The score shall be one.

PENALTIES

Who exceeds or stays under the minimum performance time by 15 seconds shall be penalized by 1 point for each one of the judges. Who makes use of chemical smoke-producers or of harmful materials (except dry ice), shall be penalized by 2 points for each one of the judges. Who makes use of objects exceeding the size permitted by the regulation will be penalized by 1 point and a half for each one of the judges. If the object shall have been taken onto the ice rink by someone different from the performing skaters, the group shall be penalized by 1 point for each one of the judges. The non-mention of a coalition with another team will cause disqualification.

Entry fee is 40€ for skater for the categories Chicks, Cubs, Basic Novice A and B, Senior, Interpretative and 50€ for skater for the categories Advanced Novice and Junior. The entry fee must be paid for each competitor at the registration before the competition. Participating teams must announce changes in their teams immediately after their arrival in office Ice Stadium Alba di Canazei.




